We record with deep regret, demise of Dr.Lekha Hrishikesan, Senior Consultant Pediatirc Nephrology, Ananthpuri Hospital and Research Institute, Thiruvananthapuram on 14th June 2020. Dr. Hrishikesan did her MBBS and MD Pediatrics from Govt.Medical College, Thiruvananthapuram. A brilliant student throughout her student days, she did DM Nephrology from Govt.Medical College, Calicut and as the first pediatrician to do DM Nephrology in Kerala. Thereafter she was awarded FRCPCH, MRPCH from Royal College of Paediatrics and Child Health, UK. She worked for 14 years at Royal Hospital, Muscat where she was instrumental in establishing Pediatric Nephrology services including dialysis and renal transplantation in Sultanate of Oman. After returning back to her home state, she joined Ananthpuri Hospital and Research Institute, Thiruvananthapuram in the department of Nephrology and continued her care for children with renal diseases. She also has been a great mentor for DNB Nephrology students in Ananthapuri Hospital.

Lekha was not only a brilliant nephrologist but also a humane person. She was an excellent home maker and a great cook too. She faced her medical illness with great courage. Our pediatric Nephrology fraternity has lost a brilliant academician, excellent colleague and a wonderful friend. Dr. Lekha Hrishikesan is survived by her husband and two children all whom are in medical fraternity.

Minutes of 31st annual GBM 2019

INDIAN SOCIETY OF PEDITRIC NEPHROLOGY

ISPN-GBM on 21 st December 2019

ISPN GBM held at AFMC Pune on 21st December 2019 was attended by 67 members.

The following are minutes of meeting:

- 1 .President Dr Amarjeet Mehta and Secretary Dr.Sidharth Sethi on chair welcomed the members gathering.
- 2. Long awaited ISPN directory was released by Dr Kumud Mehta, Dr R N Srivastva, Dr Jyoti Sharma, Dr Pankaj Hari, Dr Rajiv Sinha and Dr Kishore Phadke. Members were requested to validate Name and Contact on ISPN website if any change required.
- 2. Data of neonatal AKI consortium till date were presented by Dr Sidarth Sethi.
- 3. ISPN- CKD registry details were presented by Dr Sidharth Sethi. Total participating centres are 58 with 1004 patients registered so far. It was suggested by members to add old CKD data to the current data.
- 4. New Team was chosen in the form of Dr O P Mishra as next president and Dr Anil Vasudevan as secretary proposed by Dr R N Srivastava and seconded by Dr Abhijit Saha (Dr Mishra) and Dr Vaishali More (Dr Vasudevan) . The team will work for next 2 years.
- 5. It was suggested to continue term of zonal representive up to 3 years.Dr Pankaj Hari suggested to hold meeting of zonal representatives at least twice an year.
- 6. Zonal representatives: It was suggested to mail their responsibilities

- 7. For working group on various guidelines like AKI and UTI it was suggested to involve persons well recognised and working in the respective areas.
- Accounts wer presented by Dr Aditi Sinha. For ISPN registry funds from Dr Rajapurkar were assured. Dr Aditi suggested increasing funding of ISPN.

- 9. Dr Sushmita Banerjee IPNA councillor from India informed about the bid for IPNA from ISPN which however could not be materialised. She also informed about taking over of Dr Pankaj Hari as next IPNA councillor from India. 7 IPNA teaching coursed were held this year. 4 fellows received funding from IPNA for the conference. 65 delegates attended IPNA Venice from India. Prof Bagga and dr Nammalwar were congratulated for IPNA awards with huge applaud.
- 10. Dr RanjeetThergaonkar was asked to write a letter to GOI for addressing issues like nonavailability of certain medicines.
- 11. Dr. A.S. Vasudev suggested starting fellowship awards to senior members of ISPN for their services.
- 12. Prof R N Srivastava suggested to form a committee of members to modify rules and bylaws if any needed. A committee of following was constituted:
